## **Curriculum Update**





## **Curriculum Intentions Focus:**

To find their own voice and communicate with purpose To make meaningful choices and make them known

This half term blue corridor's topic is **Music Through The Ages** (80's, 90's, 00's and 10's). We will be exploring different eras of music; listening to different songs and watching the music videos. This will be presented within 'We are going on a Festival Hunt' which is our own adaptation of the popular story 'We are going on a Bear Hunt'. Learners will be encouraged to make meaningful choices by choosing which songs/eras they do and don't like as well as selecting a song from each era from a choice board to listen with the class. In Art, Cooking and Science, we will be partaking in activities that allow learners to use their voice and communicate with purpose, e.g. asking for ingredients, selecting art resource they want/need. In Cooking this half term, we will be making: Jamin Jam tarts, Record Bagels and Wraps. Learners will be practicing their spreading and cutting skills as well as making choices about what they want in their bagels and wraps. Within the half term, we will be making our own rain maker and tambourine to create our own music as well as making choices about how to decorate it.



## **Home Learning Opportunities**



Activities to complement the curriculum that you can do with your young person at home or out and about in the community:

- Listen to songs from different decades.
- Share with your child a song from your childhood.
- Make Jam Tarts at home as they will be familiar with the steps after they have made them in school.
- You could make rainmakers together using a tube or an old bottle and allow them to choose how they want to decorate it.
- Create opportunities where your child needs to make meaningful choices, e.g. what they want to wear at the weekend (from a given choice), what snack they want, if they want to go in the garden or to the park.
